

Who May Benefit From Treatment?

Individuals with the following symptoms may benefit from treatment:

- Depression or anxiety
- Sudden onset of hallucinations, delusions or paranoia
- Potential danger to self or others
- Noncompliance with prescribed psychiatric health regimen
- Problems coping with stressful situations
- Sudden change in ability to attend to normal daily activities
- Modification of psychotropic medication
- Cognitive impairment (Dementia with complications, Delirium)
- Behavioral issues with youth (school difficulties, poor impulse control, self-harm, oppositional/defiant behavior)

INSURANCES ACCEPTED:

Children/Adolescents/Adults under age 21: Medicare, Medicaid, and private insurance

Adults age 21 to 64: Medicare and private Insurance

Adults over age 64: Medicare, Medicaid, managed care/ private insurance

TREATMENT PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Under the direction of a psychiatrist, an individualized treatment plan is prepared for each patient. Process groups provide the core therapeutic interventions and are complimented by didactic educational groups, individual therapy, family therapy, and social work services. Nurses, master's level therapists, recreation therapists, and mental health technicians provide daily programming. The program is designed to help patients learn new skills to live a happier life, improve relationships, and function in a healthier manner with their families, in school, and in the community.

PROGRAMS

INPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAMS provide treatment for individuals who require 24-hour care in a highly structured environment. The focus of treatment is on crisis intervention, stabilization and assessment of the patient's needs. The treatment team, led by a psychiatrist, provides services that include individual, family and group therapies, educational groups, recreational therapy and discharge planning.

GENERATIONS PROGRAM FOR SENIORS offers a comfortable environment for older adults experiencing symptoms, including, but not limited to, complications with memory loss, depression, and medication management issues. An interdisciplinary treatment approach is utilized through a clinically sophisticated, safe, supportive, and responsive treatment environment. Our goal is to maximize the overall functioning of the older adult and enhance the quality of life.

PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM is an intensive, goal-oriented day treatment program that assists patients in overcoming emotional and behavioral problems. The program is comprised of five hours of treatment daily, Monday through Friday, and is a less restrictive option than inpatient hospitalization. Clients are supervised during the day, but they can return to home in the evening and weekends and maintain their independent functioning and ties to their family and community.
